



This course provides the skills and knowledge required to recognise and respond to life-threatening emergencies in line with first aid guidelines determined by the Australian Resuscitation Council (ARC) and other Australian national peak clinical bodies.

This unit applies to all persons who may be required to provide an emergency response in a range of situations, including community and workplace settings.

COURSE DURATION

AEA Training offers the following options:

1 day face to face workshop: This is full face to face course and participants are required to attend the full day.

CERTIFICATE

On successful completion of this course, you will be issued a statement of attainment in:

- HLTAID009 Provide cardiopulmonary resuscitation
- HLTAID010 Provide basic emergency life support

COURSE OUTLINE

The course covers the following:

- Roles and responsibilities of the first aider
- The DRSABCD action plan and responding to emergency situations
- Managing unconscious casualties
- Cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR)
- Using a defibrillator (AED)
- Legal issues in first aid
- Infection control
- Asthma
- Allergic reactions and Anaphylaxis
- Non-Life-threatening bleeding
- Cardiac conditions including chest pain
- Stroke
- Choking

ASSESSMENT METHODS

A successful outcome for this statement of attainment will be determined by a range of different methods including:

- written assessment
- observation of simulated and practical activities etc.

You will be required to demonstrate CPR on a manikin on the floor.
